

# Covid-19 Customer update

Over the coming days our team will be working to reintroduce all pre Covid-19 services for our valued members and customers in line with the Government's latest guidelines. We are aware that although restrictions have relaxed, covid-19 is still amongst us and we will continue to enforce a high standard of cleanliness and hygiene to prevent the spread of Covid-19 within our facility. Therefore, going forward all customers and staff will be required to continue wearing face coverings while in the centre. We ask that you continue to practice good hand hygiene and use the hand sanitise stations in place around the centre.

All changes in timetables and services will be updated on our website and social media sites. A copy of timetables and changes in services will also be available in reception. Please see below a brief outline of the changes that will take place in the leisure centre this week.

- Customer contact details will no longer be required when visiting the centre.
- Pool and gym facilities will return to full capacity. This means there will no longer be session times and customers may use the facilities during public swim times as highlighted on our timetable.
- All exercise classes will return to full capacity.
- The sauna and steam room will reopen.
- Our Vanity area is open and the use of hair dryers is now permitted.
- Changing rooms and showers are now open for all users.
- Viewing area will reopen to customers.
